

Plakous Therapeutics Presents Data at 2018 MHSRS Meeting

Winston-Salem, NC (August 23, 2018) – Plakous Therapeutics, Inc., a Winston-Salem based biotherapeutics company, presented recent data at the 2018 Military Health System Research Symposium (MHSRS) in Kissimmee, FL, earlier this week. The data showed the pre-clinical characterization and efficacy in post-traumatic osteoarthritis (PTOA) of its lead product, Protego-PD™. The work was done in collaboration with researchers at Wake Forest University School of Medicine.

"Plakous is thrilled to participate in MHSRS this week as we work to translate our learnings into improved care of the solider. We are committed to improving the lives of patients with osteoarthritis in developing our lead product," said Dr. Seth Tomblyn, CSO of Plakous Therapeutics and lead author on the paper. "As our research at MHSRS shows, the growth factor and cytokine milieu of Protego-PD™ is similar to amniotic fluid. Protego-PD™ protected and grew cartilage cells in cell culture and protected joint cartilage in a rodent severe knee injury model of PTOA. People living with osteoarthritis presently have no FDA approved options beyond pain management until their joints deteriorate to the point that joint replacement is required. Should our results hold in further testing, Protego-PD™ would represent a paradigm shift in the treatment of PTOA."
